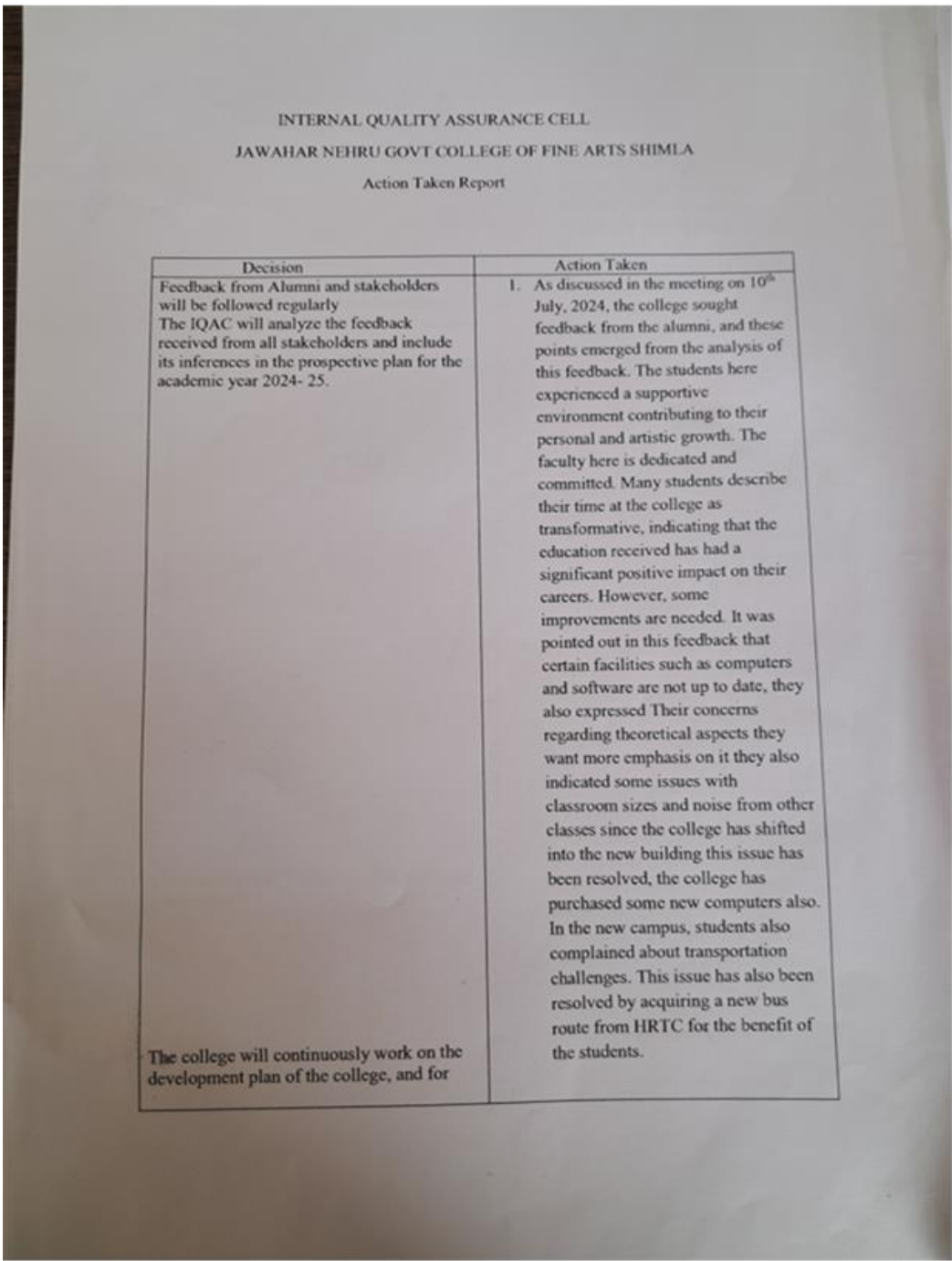

In the new campus, students also complained about transportation challenges. This issue has also been resolved by acquiring a new bus route from HRTC for the benefit of the students.</p>
