- **Foster Personal Expression:** Offer a safe space for inmates to explore and express their emotions and thoughts through artistic mediums.
- **Document and Share Inmate Narratives:** The College's Human Library Club will document the stories of inmates who wish to share their experiences, with the option to publish these narratives if consented.

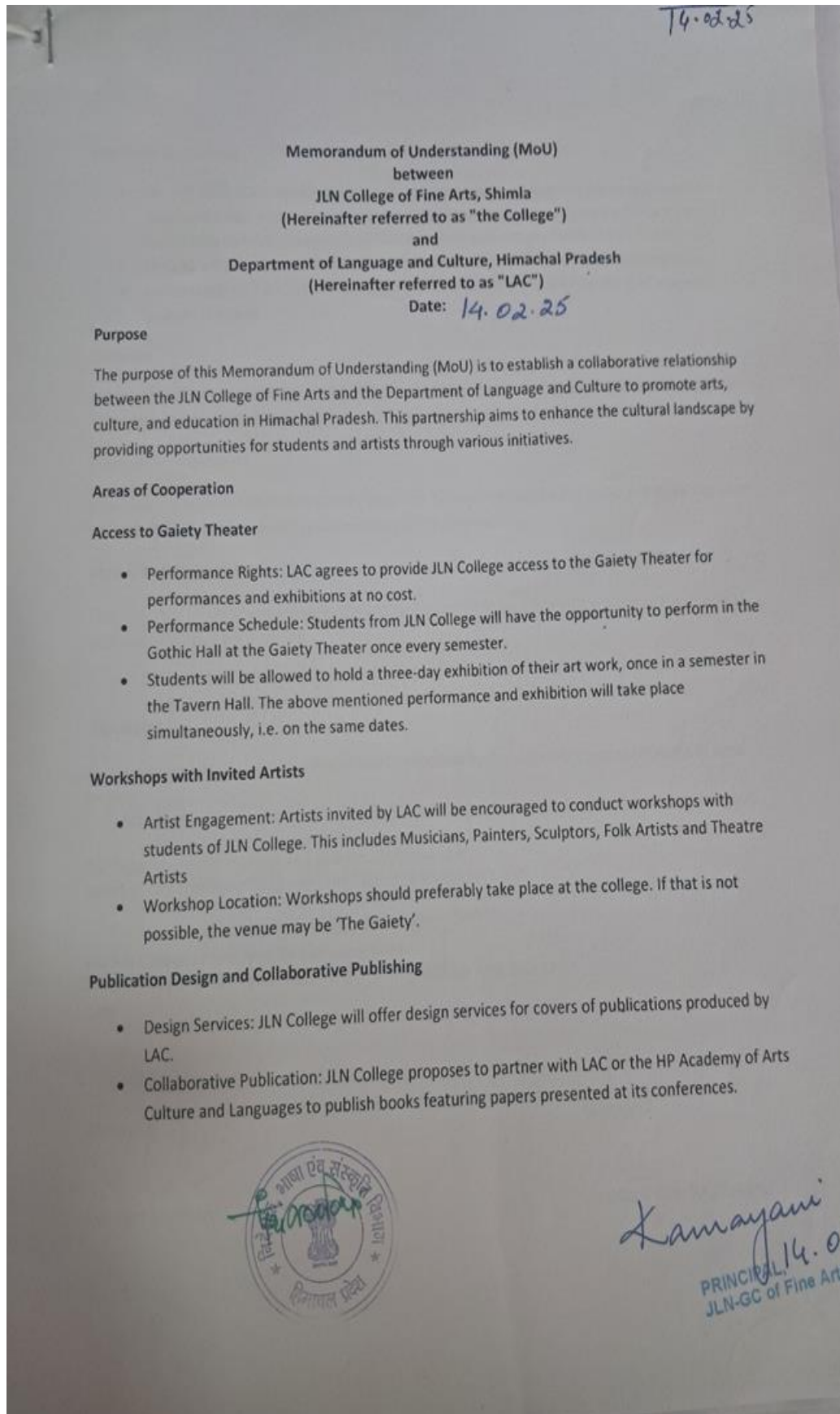

Financial arrangements related to specific programs or initiatives will be discussed and agreed upon in advance by both parties, ensuring transparency and accountability.




